#### 3. Organizational Changes (Effective January 1, 2026)

(1) Launch of Strategic Business Units (SBUs)

To strengthen the organizational functions of the Segments(\*) established in January 2023 and enhance our competitiveness, we will abolish the division-based structure that has formed the Segments and newly establish Strategic Business Units (SBUs) that drive value creation from a market-oriented perspective as the new constituent organizations of the Segments. This approach will reinforce synergies among customer bases and technologies, optimize our business portfolio through targeted investments in growth areas, and accelerate our efforts

#### (\*) Refers to the following Segments

toward future business growth.

Mechatronics Segment, Industrial Machinery Segment, Logistics & Construction Segment, Energy & Lifeline Segment

#### <Mechatronics Segment>

 The Power Transmission & Controls Group, the Precision Component Group, and the Mechatronics Group will be dissolved and replaced with the newly established Drive Technologies SBU and Advanced Technologies SBU

#### <Industrial Machinery Segment>

 The Plastics Machinery Division and the Industrial Equipment Division will be dissolved and replaced with the newly established Material Solutions SBU, Medical & Quantum Solutions SBU, Metal Processing Solutions SBU, and Plastics Solutions SBU

#### <Logistics & Construction Segment>

 The Material Handling Systems SBU, the HSC Cranes SBU, the Link-Belt Cranes SBU, and the Construction Equipment SBU will be newly established

## <Energy & Lifeline Segment>

 The Energy & Environment Group, the Ship & Marine Division, and the Process Machinery Center will be dissolved and replaced with the newly established Energy & Environment SBU, Process Plant SBU, and Marine & Steel Structures SBU

#### (2) Organizational changes at the head office

- 1. The Corporate Planning Group will be restructured into the Corporate Global Strategy Group
  - (a) The Corporate Planning Department will be renamed to the Strategic Planning Department

- (b) The Corporate Communications will absorb the Corporate Identity Promotion Department
- (c) The Globalization Department and the New Business Exploration Department will be dissolved and merged into the Corporate Global Strategy Group
- 2. The Semiconductor Business Development Department will be newly established
